### ART BESSE PIONEER AWARD

As WETA's highest honor, the Art Besse Pioneer Award was created in honor of its namesake, Art Besse. Art was a founding member of WETA and a great humanitarian. He served the people of Wisconsin through a long and successful career with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. The Art Besse Pioneer Award was created to recognize individuals whose achievement and excellence in the field of employment & training through a sustained career in the industry have made a profound impact on the lives of others. The nominee does not have to be a WETA member but must be nominated by a WETA member.

### 2017 EXCELLENCE AWARDS

#### Employment and Training Administration Excellence Award

The nominee does not have to be a WETA member but must be nominated by a WETA member. Nominee must be an administrator, supervisor, coordinator, project director, planner, or hold another administrative position with an organization that provides employment & training services at any level. Nomination should be based on activities from October 2016 - September 2017.

#### Employment and Training Staff Excellence Award

The nominee does not have to be a WETA member but must be nominated by a WETA member. Nominee must be a non-administrative staff person who works directly with clients/customers or who supports the staff members who work directly with clients/customers. Nomination should be based on activities from October 2016 - September 2017.

#### Kaleidoscope Excellence Award

The nominee must be a WETA member nominated by a WETA member. Nomination should be based on the individual's contributions to expanding awareness of and respect for diversity in the workplace. There is no timeframe requirement. The award recipient receives complimentary registration fees (including meals but not lodging) for the WETA 2018 Annual Conference. But wait! The Kaleidoscope Award is doubled and pays a 2<sup>nd</sup> registration fee (including meals but not lodging) so that a work colleague of the Kaleidoscope Award recipient's choice who is not a current WETA member may attend the WETA 2018 Annual Conference.
